



Intellectual Property

The majority of projects supported by the Foundation entails creation of intellectual products. These include: publications, analytical reports, educational courses and programs, author's methodologies, audiovisual works, museum expositions, books and research etc.

We comply with regulations in intellectual property rights, authors' rights, copyright and related rights in our activities. We expect compliance with these regulations from our grantees including their partners, contractors and other third parties.

Exceptional rights to the intellectual activities' results received in the course of projects' implementation always belong to the Foundations' grantees: authors and their organizations.

However, the Foundation reserve the right to publish and issue various information materials on supported projects to inform the audience. To select materials we draw on the results of projects' monitoring including visits to grantees' organizations, participation in their events and on the data from digital monitoring: grantees' publications in projects diaries, their reports and other public information.

We use the results of grantees' intellectual labour gratis under the terms of non-exclusive license to inform the audience about our projects.

The Foundation and its grantees also confer rights to each other to use image data (logos) on their official websites and projects' publications and materials.

We follow the regulations on copyright and related rights protection. For this reason, in accordance with the Russian Federation Civil Code articles 431.2 and 152.1., we ask all grantees to give representations that:

- all permissions and approvals to use names, titles, literary works, brand names, service marks, logos, video and photo materials and other results of intellectual property and equivalent means of identification will be obtained;
- individuals' consent to photo and video recording and publication of photo and video recordings received in the course of projects' implementation will be obtained.
